# HIMALAYA EXCHANGE WEBSITE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

#### 1 **About our Terms**

- 1.1 These Website Terms and Conditions of use (the Terms) explain how you may use this website https://himalaya.exchange and all associated web pages provided by the Himalaya Exchange its subsidiaries and affiliates (the Site).

companies from time to time; and

(f) You

means the person accessing or using the Site or its Content (and your shall have the same meaning).
